## Our interdisciplinary approach

At Scope, we believe that creativity and innovation flourish at the intersection of disciplines, where each area of expertise provides a unique lens and perspective. Our innovation-driven team includes highly talented and passionate members from designers and creatives to international development experts and public health specialists. Together, we work on projects to create context-adapted and planet-positive solutions that put people, alongside systems, at the centre of problem-solving.
